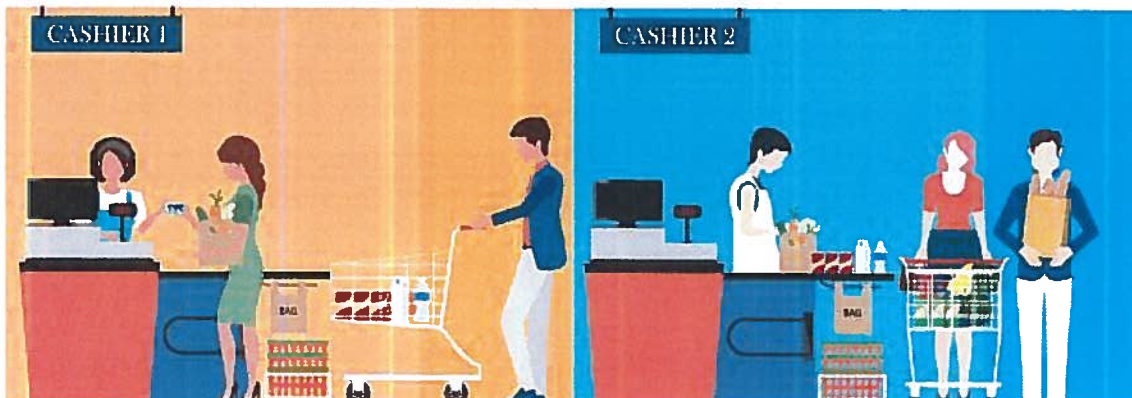

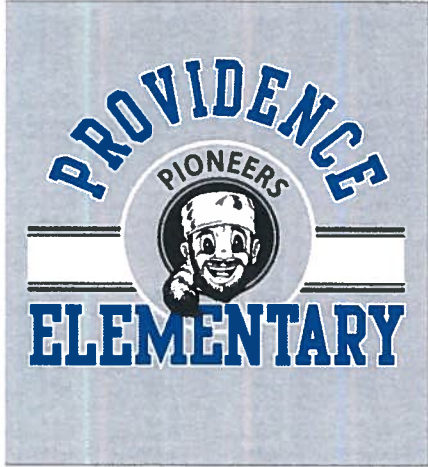

Providence Elementary School Health and Physical Education Department



Dear Parents,

Welcome back for another exciting school year! We anticipate a school year filled with many fun activities that will challenge your student physically and mentally. We will introduce a variety of games, activities, and skills that will progress throughout the year. Some of the movement skills students should look forward to learning are throwing/catching, striking with implements, basketball, soccer, gymnastics and dance. We will also be learning about different health topics such as fitness (including fitness testing with 3-5), nutrition, muscles/bones and the cardiorespiratory system. Students will also learn about sportsmanship, teamwork and responsibility.

Grades K-5 need to be prepared for physical education every day. The P.E. staff would like to make this year a safe and enjoyable one for all students. To accomplish this goal, please keep these guidelines in mind and discuss them with your student:

- Proper shoes should be worn during gym class. Preferably tennis shoes or similar rubber bottom sole shoes. If your child wears shoes that are not appropriate for PE they may bring a separate pair to change into. Students will **NOT** participate if proper shoes are not worn. Instead, the student will complete an alternate assignment.
- Shorts should be worn underneath skirts and dresses
- Please inform the physical education teacher and clinic of any medical conditions that may affect their participation in physical activity by written letter or email.
- Students may be excused from physical activity if a written note is received by a member of the physical education staff. The note should state the nature of the child's condition and the number of days the student is to be excused from activity. **Per the VBCPS students handbook a doctor's note is required for a student to miss an extended period of time from physical education.**

Run/Walk Program

Students will have the opportunity to participate in a Run/Walk program during recess. During this time students may choose to run/walk laps to earn beads. Laps will be tracked by dotting hands with a non-toxic washable marker. If you absolutely would not like your child to have dots please let the PE department know by written note.

Behavior Management

- Warning: (student reminded of appropriate behavior)
- YELLOW: timeout (behavior reflection in our cool down area)
- RED card and removal from activity for entirety of bell

This card will be given to the student, and must be signed and returned by the parent or guardian the next school day. If a red card is not returned by the student, a phone call or email will be made to the parent/guardian.
