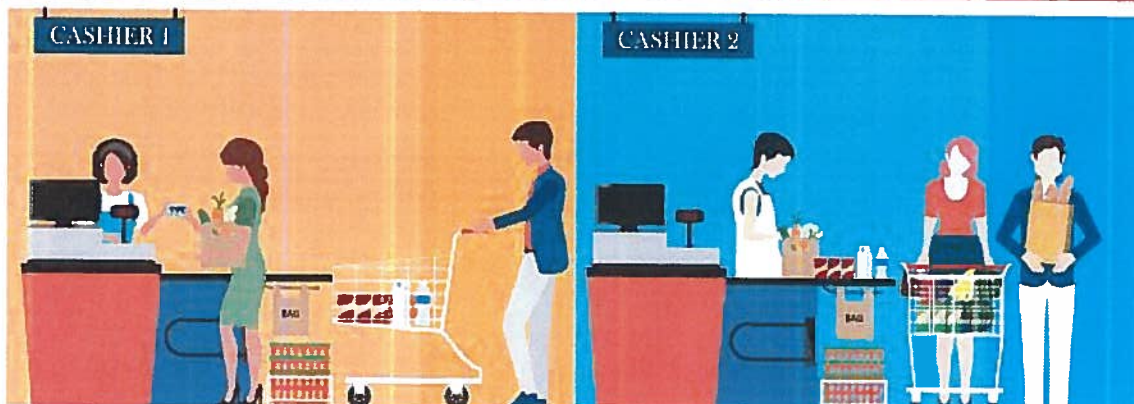

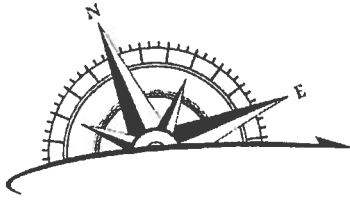

Dear Parents,

Virginia's Early Intervention Reading Initiative was established in 1997 by the Virginia Legislature and is coordinated by the Virginia Department of Education. The initiative seeks to identify and reduce the number of children with reading problems through instruction of early literacy skills. The initiative includes three elements.

1. Phonological awareness screening is provided for kindergarten, first and second grade students in the fall of each school year. Third grade students who are new to Virginia are also provided the phonological awareness assessment in the fall.
2. Phonological awareness and literacy intervention is provided for those students who need additional practice as determined by the results of the screening.
3. Post-screening will be conducted in May to determine growth. Third grade students receiving intervention will not participate in the post-screening due to SOL testing.

Phonological awareness is the ability to hear the sounds that make up words, recognize relationships between sounds and to alter and rearrange sounds to create new words. According to the guidelines of the Early Intervention Reading Initiative grant, those students requiring additional practice as measured by the state approved assessment, Phonological Awareness Literacy Screening (PALS) instrument, receive an additional 30 minutes of reinforcement of early reading and writing skills in a group of five or fewer students.

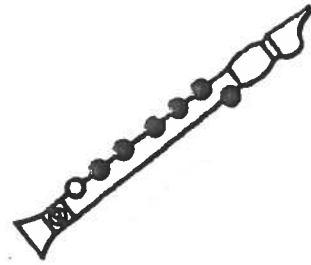
An instructional support staff is assigned throughout the school division to assist schools with the Phonological Awareness Literacy Screening and early literacy instruction. The fall screening will begin September 16 for grades 1-3 and October 14 for kindergarten. The spring screening will begin in April 27 for all elementary schools.

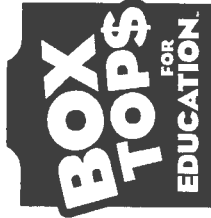
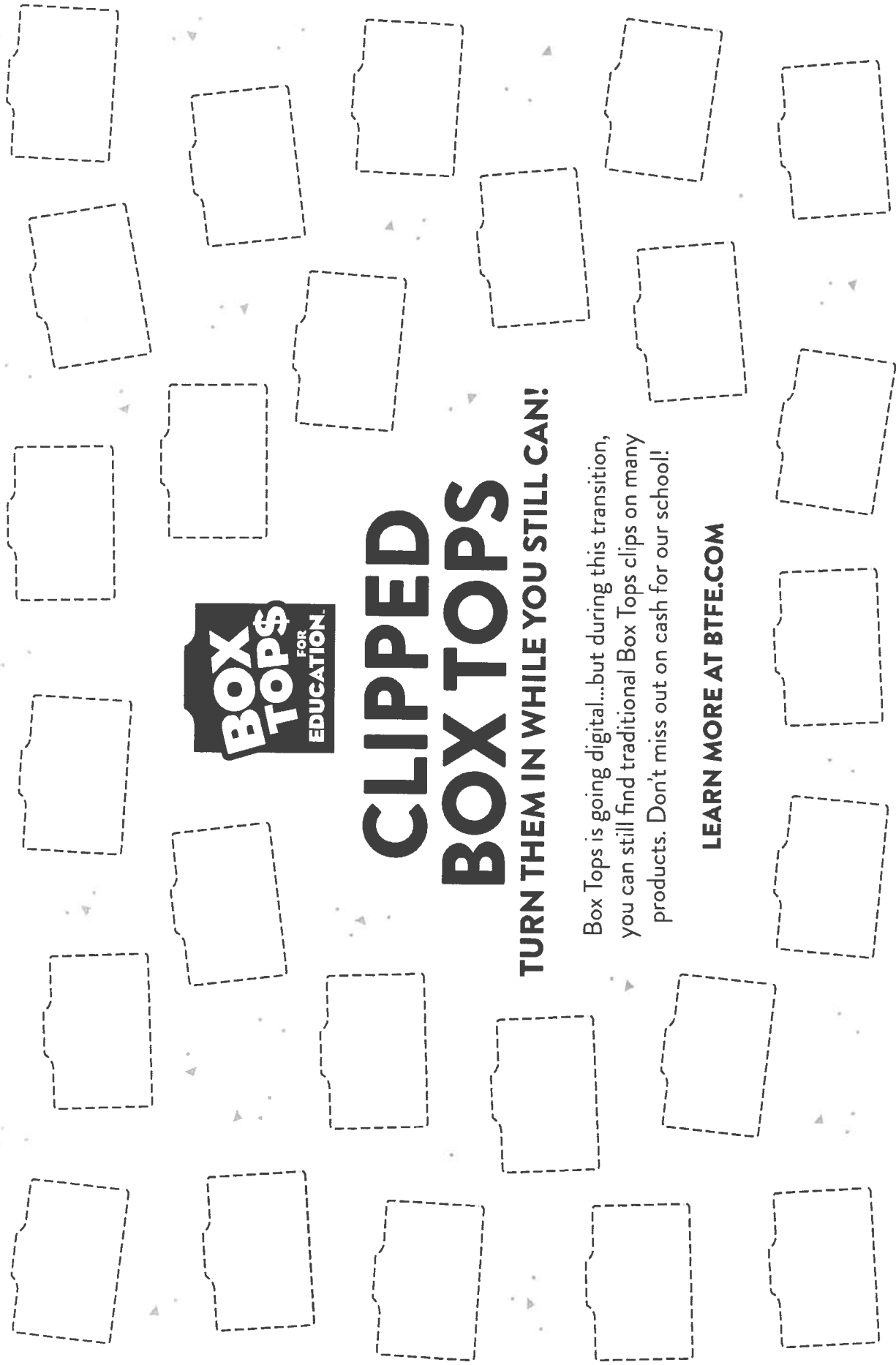
